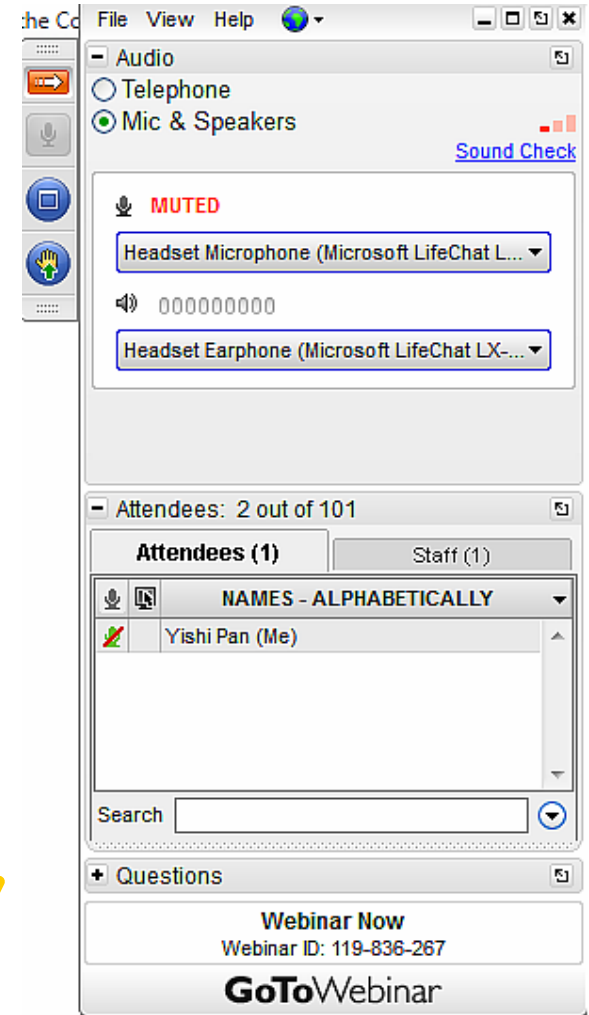

Personal Digital Assistant (PDA)

- Overview
- Intermec CN 70 vs. CK71

The primary difference between the CN 70 and CK71 is that the CN70 has the option for a **built-in cellular component**.



Key features of the PDA devices

- Drop Survival of 8ft to concrete
- Operation in extreme temperature conditions (-4° F to +140° F)
- Resistance to rain and dust
- High-Durability touch screen
- Internal power supply (prevents data loss if battery runs out)

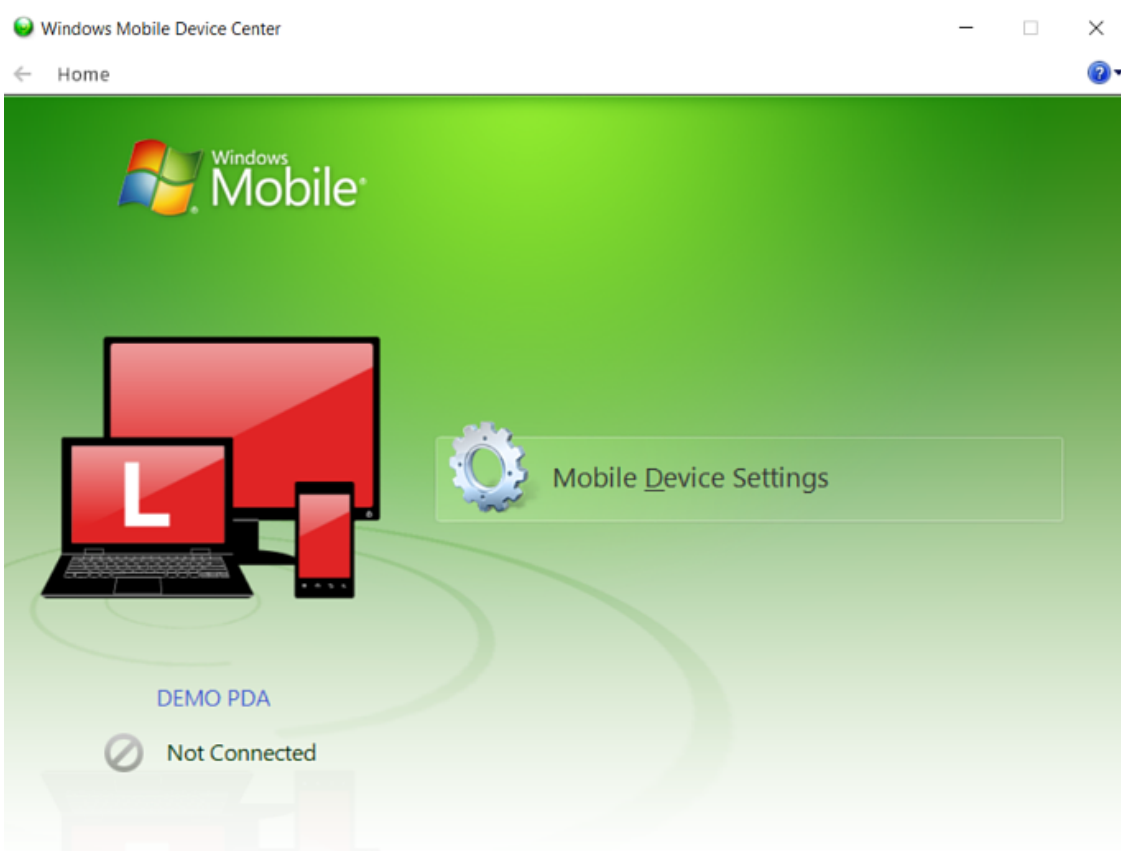
Step 2:

Connect the PDA to the Computer
through the micro USB cable

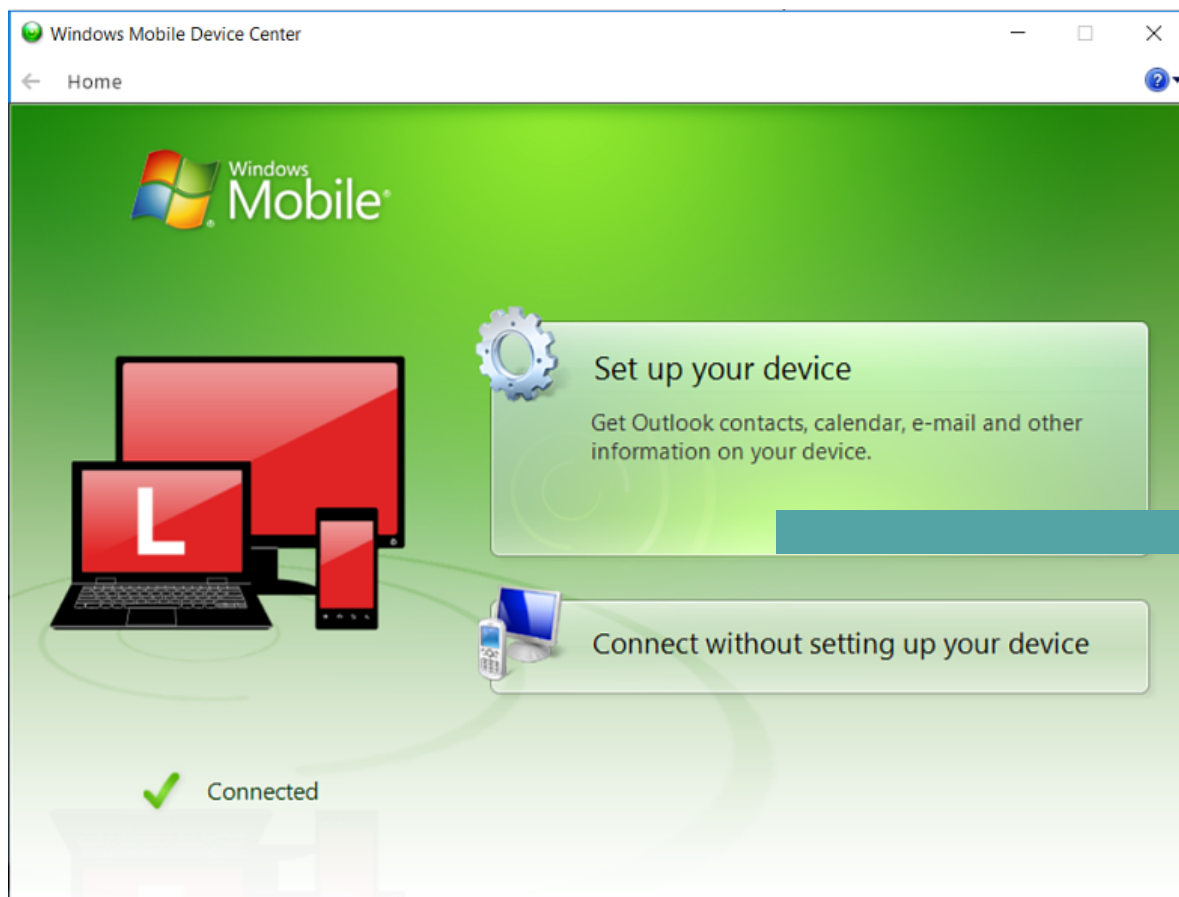
Note: you must also have the power connected to the base

Step 3:

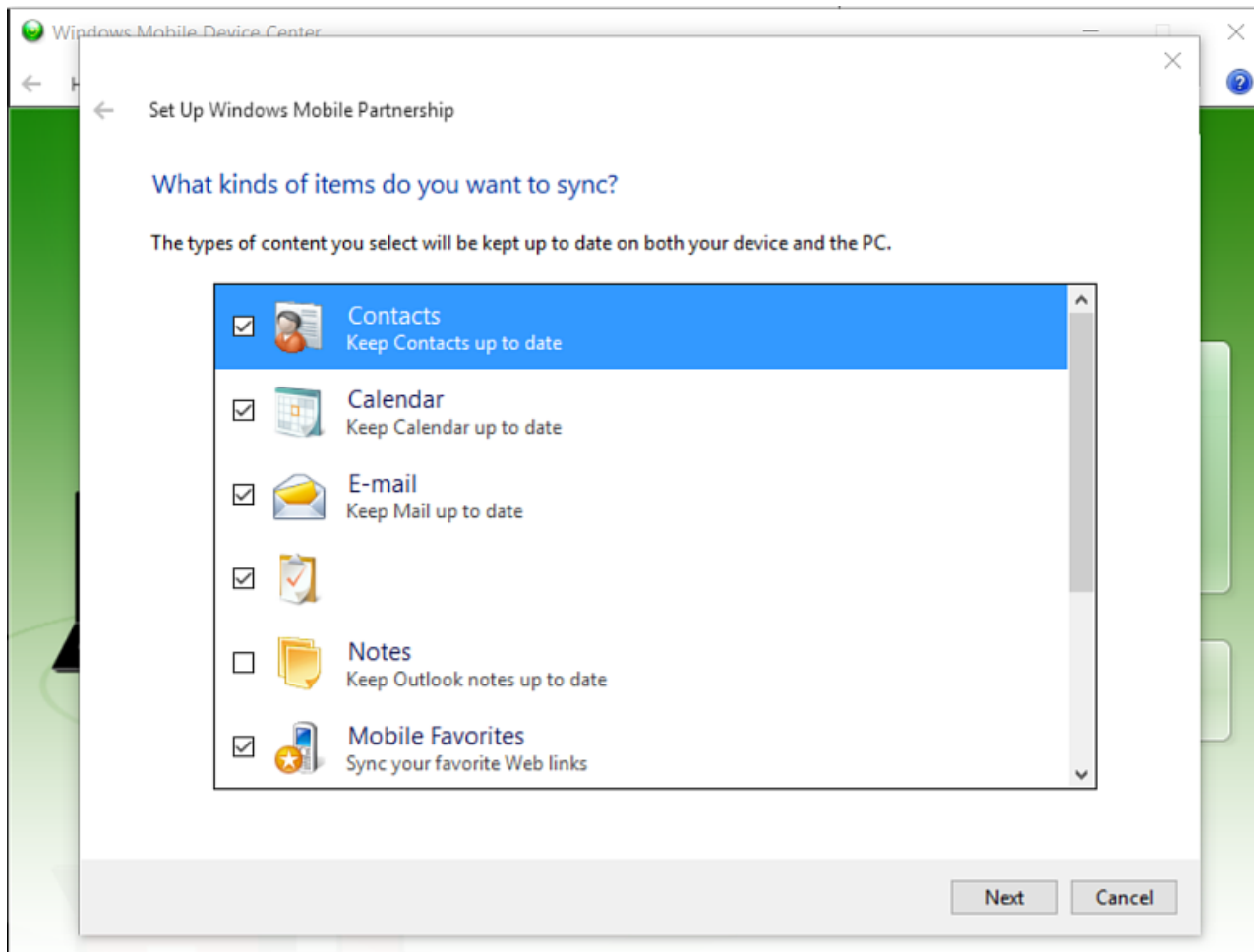
Synchronize the PDA with your computer



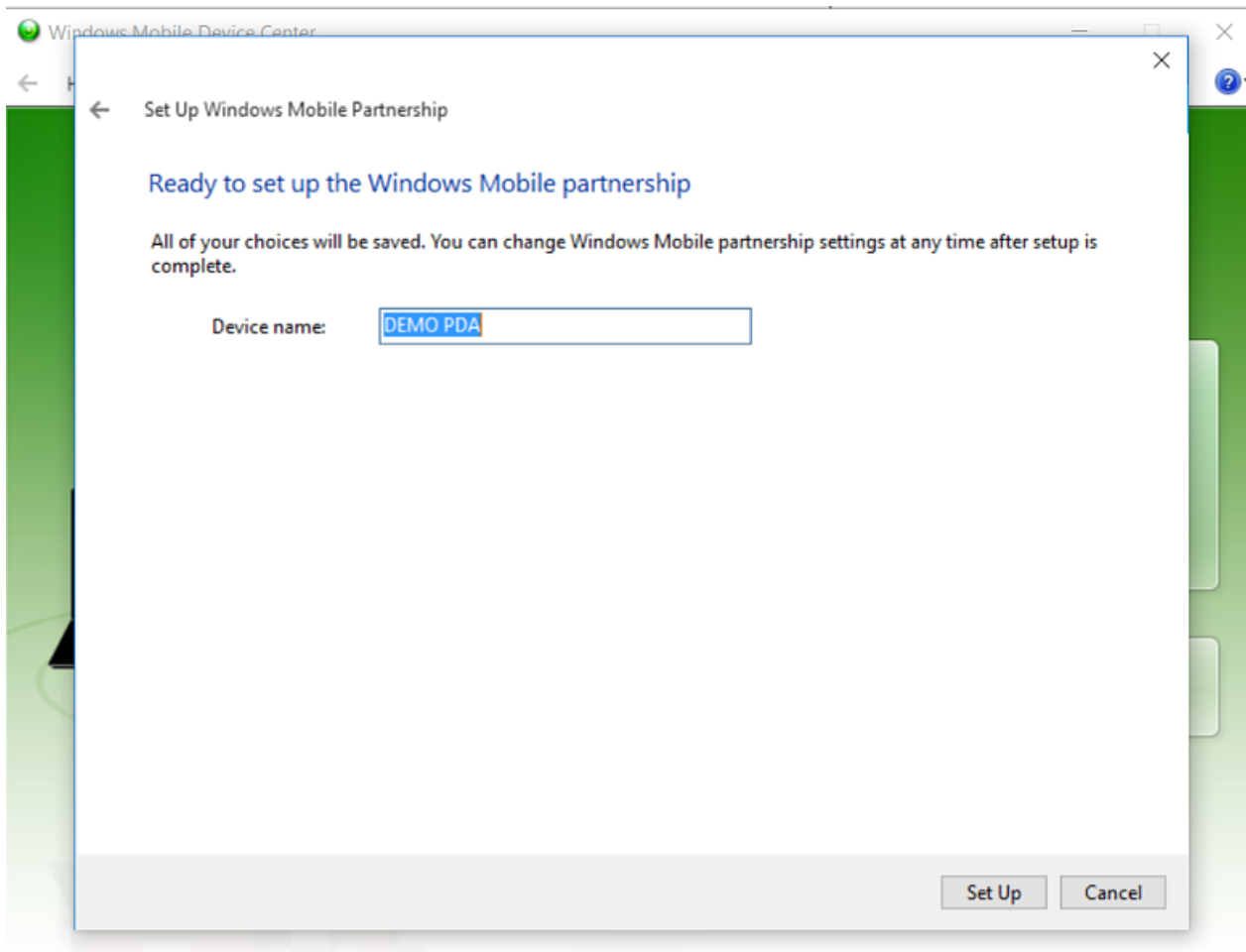
a). Main Page



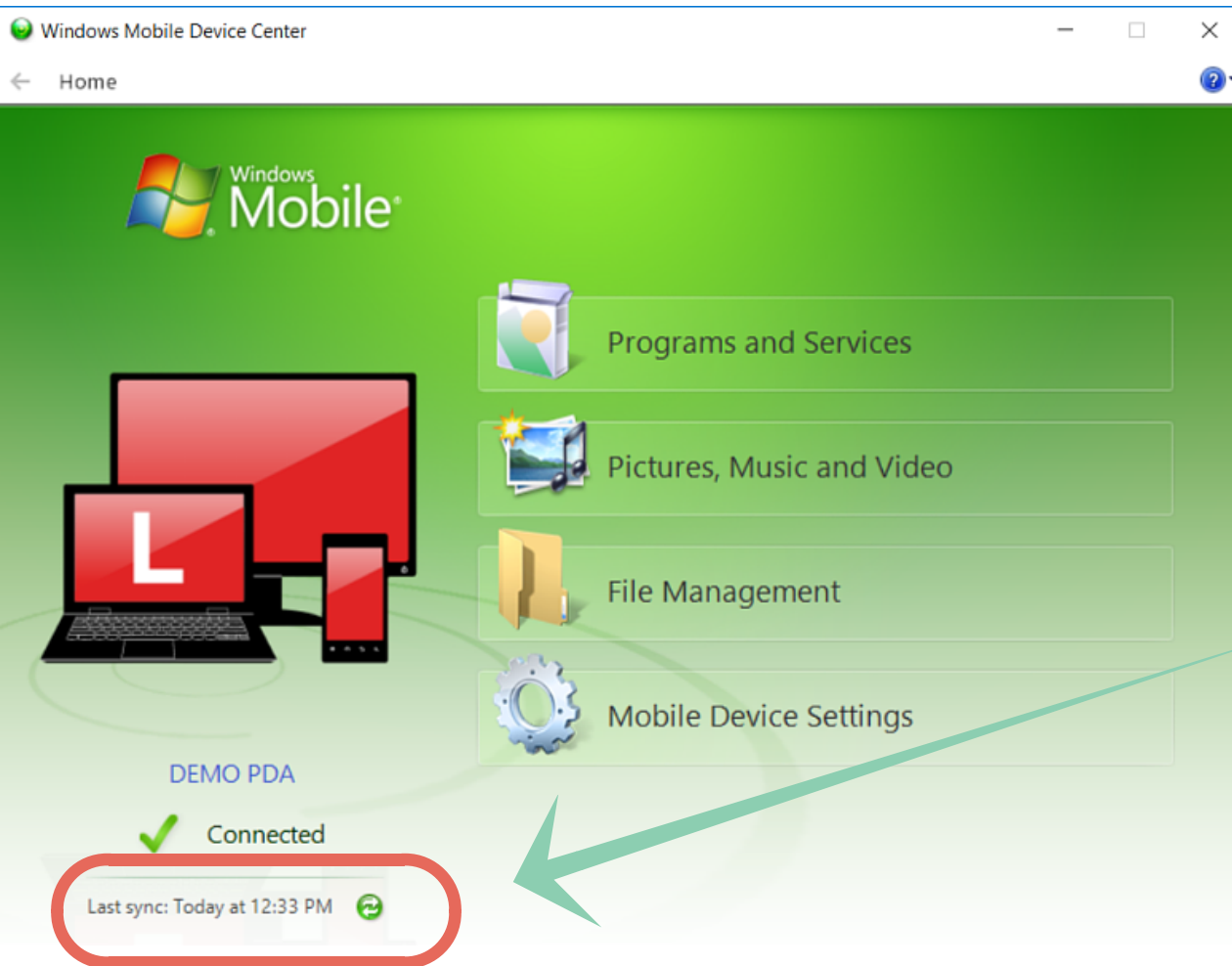
b). CLICK, Set up your device



c). deselect all options,
hit "Next"



d). Name your PDA



e). PDA is now synchronized with your computer

Installing the PPC

1. Obtain the PPC

- Log into ftp site:

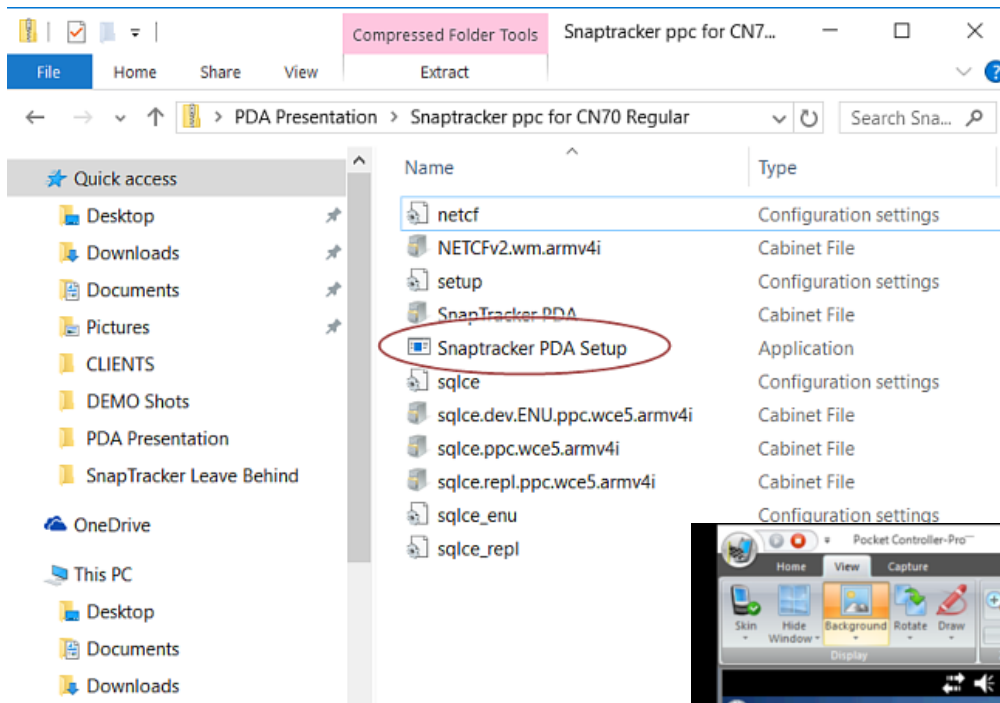

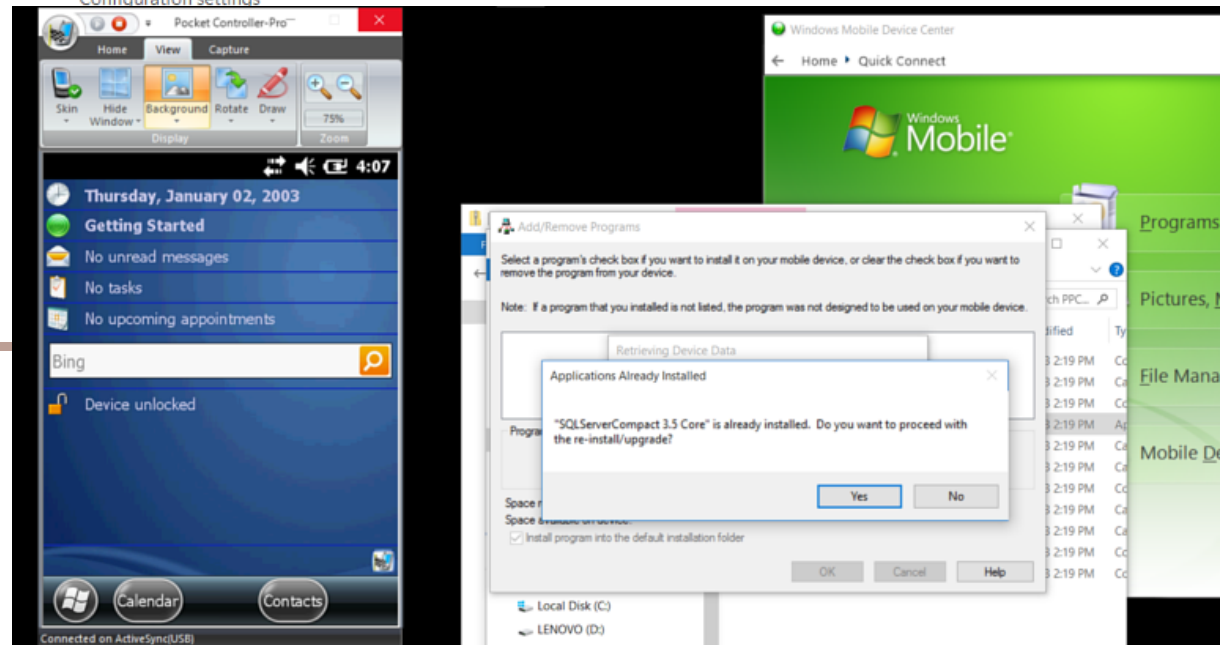

3. Follow the on-screen instructions

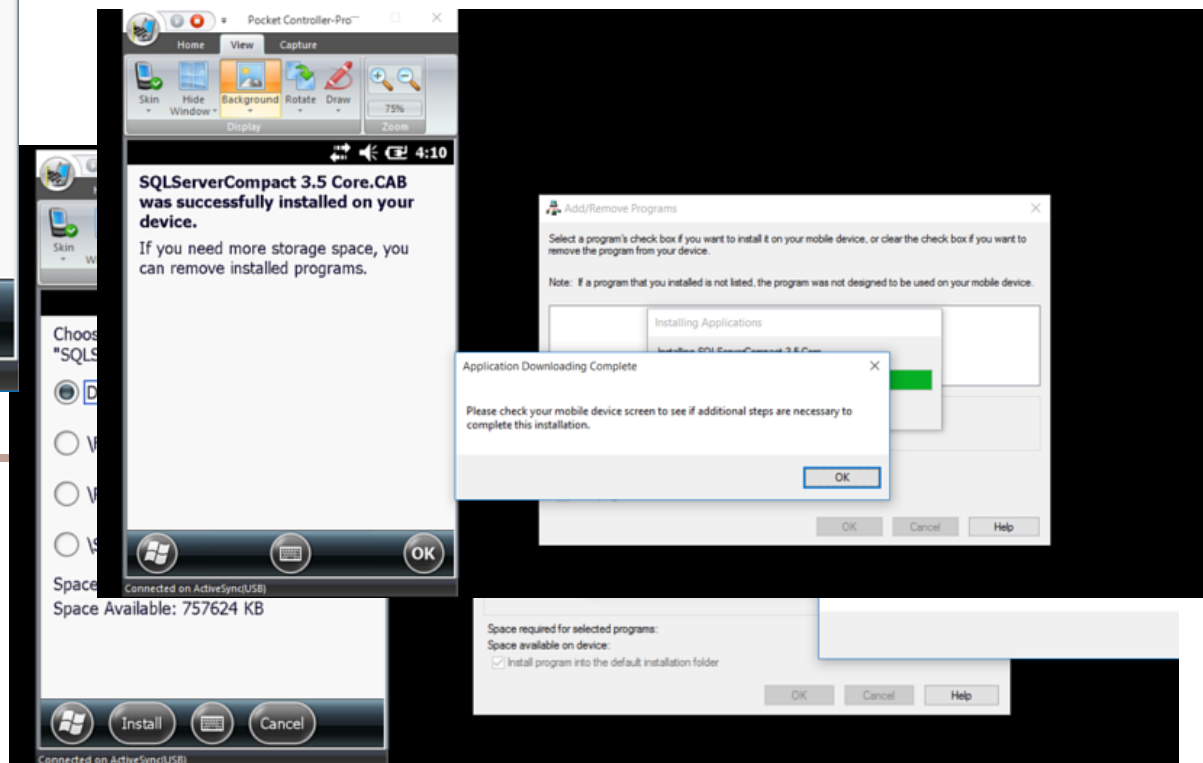
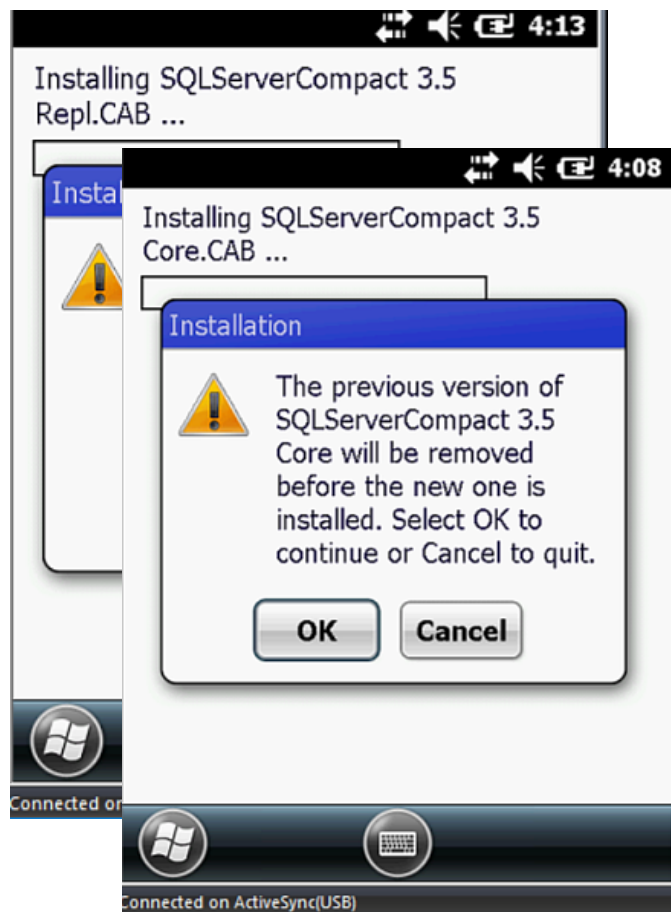


You will then be prompted to confirm the installation on **both** your desktop and the PDA.

You will have to do this about 4 times.

Note:

When you first purchased the PDA from KiSP, you will received the PDA with the application installed. This is meant to be a guide in case you have to re-install the application on the PDA.



After you've successfully installed the App, a new icon called SnapTracker appears on the PDA.



When you launch the application for the first time, you will automatically go into the **connection settings**.



Best Practices



1. Check the date & time before heading out to scan

- If PDA powers down completely, it softboot to the manufacturer's default date & time, which is back in 2003

2. Check the operator before scanning

- Provides a reference for the individual who did the scanning that day

3. Upload PDA data once per day (minimum)

- To maintain an up-to-date SnapTracker inventory
